Rules:

2024 USGA Rules of Golf, NCSG Rules Book and the local course rules will govern play. Only registered participants are allowed on carts. Spectators and caddies are not permitted on the courses.

Tees:

All Women and Men 80+ will play from the forward (red) tees, Men 50-59 from the White tees and Men 60-79 from the Black tees. Two-day, 36-hole tournament, both courses played. Shotgun start each day. Maximum of 250 golfers/first reply honored. USGA rules apply with tournament adaptations in the NCSG Rules Book.

NEW for 2024:

Golf Scoring: Maximum score will be utilized for both men and women. A player's maximum score for each hole shall be related to par and set at triple bogey. A player who does not complete a hole in the given number of strokes up to triple bogey, must pick up their ball and forgo any further play for that hole. This player will not be disqualified but will simply receive the maximum score for that hole equal to triple bogey.

Doubt As to Procedure:

If you are doubtful of your rights or the correct procedure, you may play a second ball under Rule 3-3 and report the facts to the Committee upon completion of the round.

PACE OF PLAY: The pace of play standard is 14 and ½ minutes per hole (4 hours & 21 minutes).

Suspension Of Play:

Suspension of play will be signaled by consecutive siren blasts. If a player has started play of a hole, he may discontinue play immediately or continue play of the hole, provided he does so without delay, rule 6-8b. **Suspension of play due to a dangerous situation** will be signaled by one prolonged siren blast and play must be discontinued immediately.

Preferred Lies:

Players are permitted to lift, clean, and place their ball within one club length of where it originally lay in their own fairway only.

Water Hazards:

Regular water hazards will be identified by yellow stakes and defined by yellow lines. Lateral water hazards will be identified by red stakes and defined by red lines.

Embedded Ball:

Relief may be taken "through the green".

Obstructions:

Gravel roads, railroad ties and landscape stones are considered immovable obstructions. Ropes and stakes are movable obstructions.

Ground Under Repair:

Defined by white lines.

Measuring Devices:

Change for 2024: Range finders of any type are permitted.

Scorecard:

A scorecard is deemed returned when the score is posted on the scoreboard, scorecards must be signed by the marker and the competitor.
