Defaulting Matches

As a courtesy to your fellow participants, if you decide to default on a match prior, notify NCSG at 919-851-5456 or ncsg@ncseniorgames.org so that your opponent may be notified. Remember, some people are driving from six hours away! **If you must default on a match call the Tennis Tournament default line at TBD.** Leave a voicemail with your name, age category and the event you are defaulting so we can contact your opponent. All other calls and information requests should go to ncsg@ncseniorgames.org or 919-851-5456.

Match Times

Match times are indicated on the tournament brackets. If they change, they will be updated on the brackets. In Doubles competition, partners compete in the age category of the younger player. You will continue to play as long as you win. Notify the Event Manager if you must forfeit your match.

Check-In

Check-in each day with a photo ID at the Millbrook Exchange Tennis Center starting at 30 minutes prior to the first match. Participants must check in 20 minutes prior to their scheduled match time. There will be a 15 minute default time.

Equipment

Balls that are used are the Pro Penn Championship Extra Duty Felt.

Seeding

Seeding is based on the 2023 State Final results.

Food

There are many restaurants near the venue. You are also welcome to bring coolers & snacks.

Nationals

2024 is a National Qualifying year for the 2025 National Senior Games in Des Moines, Iowa. Go to www.nsga.com for more details. There will be matches to decide 3rd place if both of the participants that lose their semi-final matches wish to attempt to qualify for Nationals. If either of the two individuals that lose their semi-final matches are not interested in attempting to qualify for Nationals, a 3rd place match will not be necessary and both individuals will be awarded a bronze medal.

Rules

State Finals Tennis Tournament is a single elimination event.

- Matches will be best 2 out of three sets. If players split sets, a Champions tiebreaker (first one to 10, win by 2) will be played.
- Or
- 8-game pro set (typically used for extreme weather related delays)
 - When using no-ad scoring in Mixed Doubles, when the score is 3-all (deuce), the serve must be made to the court played by the receiver who is of the same sex as the server.

Spectators and seating

Spectators must remain outside the fence at all times. Clapping and cheering is only permitted during a dead ball. Seating on the courts to rest between matches is limited. Participants are permitted to bring personal camp chairs.
